Va communities get grants for wounded warriors

RICHMOND, Va. (AP) - Community programs throughout Virginia are getting grants to help National Guard and Reserves suffering from combat-related head injuries and stress disorders.

Gov. Tim Kaine on Friday announced the \$1.7 million in grants for programs to help veterans and members not on active duty.

The funding for programs is provided by the Virginia Wounded Warrior Program. The program was created by the 2008 General Assembly to provide serves to veterans and their families.

The community boards provide things like outpatient counseling and crisis intervention, and day programs and other support for veterans with traumatic brain injuries.
