Deputy Commissioner Sloane Rose



Sloane Rose is a 33-year veteran with experience across federal and state government and the private sector.

While in uniform, Sloane held some of the U.S. military's most challenging assignments, ranging from explosive ordnance disposal to shaping national policy while serving on Capitol Hill, at the White House, and at the Pentagon. After retiring in 2025 from active duty as a full-time member of the Army National Guard—with prior service in the Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve—Sloane worked as a community organizer.

Sloane was appointed to serve as Deputy Commissioner of the Virginia Department of Veterans Services in January 2026 by Governor Abigail Spanberger. As Deputy Commissioner, she oversees the delivery of veteran services and the mission-enabling functions that support the agency.

She is a graduate of the University of Massachusetts Amherst, where she earned a Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting. Sloane holds a Master of Professional Studies in Legislative Affairs from George Washington University and is a graduate of the National War College, where she earned a Master of Science in National Security Strategy with a concentration in cybersecurity leadership.
