Veterans ID card helps veterans cash in on Veterans Day discounts

With Veterans Day just around the corner, many retailers and restaurants are offering discounts and other incentives to veterans. The card also makes it easy for retailers and restaurants to verify a veteran's status.

The veterans ID card is issued by the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles. Veterans can obtain one by visiting any DMV customer service center or mobile customer service center, online at www.dmvnow.com, by mail (P. O. Box 27412, Richmond, VA 23269), or fax (804 367-1112).

The veteran must have a valid Virginia driver's license or identification card as well as a copy of his or her DD214 or other official discharge document, along with the \$10 fee.

Veterans who apply in person at a DMV office will receive a temporary veterans ID that can be used as proof of veteran status until the veterans ID card arrives in the mail. The card should arrive within a week.
