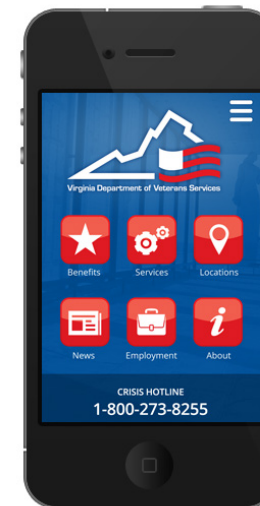

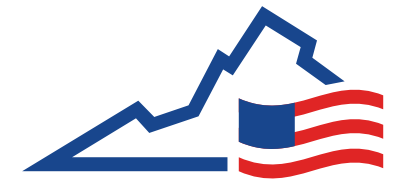

The Virginia Veteran & Family Support Program

In response to the growing need to improve and expand services to our veterans and military service members, the Commonwealth of Virginia established the Virginia Wounded Warrior Program, now named the Virginia Veteran & Family Support Program (VVFS), in 2008. VVFS coordinates behavioral, rehabilitative, and supportive services for Virginia veterans. The program ensures that veterans with stress related and traumatic brain injuries resulting from military service, and their families, receive timely assessment, treatment, and support.

The Virginia Veteran & Family Support Program team offers:

- Comprehensive Assessments of Individual and Family Needs
- Care Coordination Services for Behavioral Health, Rehabilitative and Supportive Services
- Direct Linkage to Treatment Services for Post Traumatic Stress and Traumatic Brain Injury
- Direct Linkage to VA Benefits and Healthcare, Employment, and Education Services
- Peer Support Services
- Family Support Services
- Support Groups
- Homeless and Housing Services
- Criminal Justice and Re-Entry Services
- Outreach and Education Services



Funding

The Virginia General Assembly appropriates funds for VVFS. Although generous, state funding is not sufficient to provide an adequate level of service to Virginia's veterans and families. Support from individuals, veterans service organizations, and the private sector is crucial.
