


About the Virginia Department of Veterans Services:
The Virginia Department of Veterans Services (DVS) is a state government agency with more than 40 locations across the Commonwealth of Virginia. DVS traces its history to 1928 and the establishment of the Virginia War Service Bureau to assist Virginia's World War I veterans. Today, DVS assists veterans and their families in filing claims for federal veterans benefits; provides veterans and family members with linkages to services including behavioral health, housing, employment, education and other programs. The agency operates four long-term care facilities offering in-patient skilled nursing care, Alzheimer's/memory care, and short-term rehabilitation for veterans; and provides an honored final resting place for veterans and their families at three state veterans cemeteries. It operates the Virginia War Memorial, the Commonwealth's tribute to Virginia's men and women who gave the ultimate sacrifice from World War II to the present. The Jones & Cabacoy Veterans Care Center offers unparalleled short-term and long-term nursing care, rehabilitation and life experiences exclusively for Virginia veterans. It is nestled on twenty-five beautiful wooded acres surrounded by walking trails and ponds in the Princess Anne community of Virginia Beach.

AMENITIES

Construction of the Jones & Cabacoy Veterans Care Center was completed in 2023 and includes the latest in technology and design features. The Center is one-story throughout and features eight 16-room households. Each household has a common living room, kitchenette and dayroom with access to an open courtyard. Every resident enjoys a spacious private room with restroom and walk-in shower. Plus, there are lounges located throughout the Center and residents also have access to a game room, library, activity rooms, and chapel to pursue individual interests. Weekly worship services and non-denominational study groups are held onsite and visits from clergy are encouraged.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Honorable discharge from any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces, National Guard or Reserves.
- Virginia residency at the time of admission or entry into the Armed Forces from Virginia.
- Meets medical requirements for nursing home care. *Our admissions staff can provide complete details on these criteria.*

The Jones & Cabacoy Veterans Care Center accepts payment from private insurers, Medicare and Medicaid. Most veterans also qualify for the VA (U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs) per-diem facility credit.
