COMING FROM I-81 NORTH

- Take exit 143 and merge on to I-581 South. Go I.I miles
- Take exit 2S for Peters Creed Road/VA-117 South. Go .2 miles
- 3. Turn right at Peters Creek Road/VA-VA-117 South. Follow Peters Creek Road for 3.7 miles
- Turn right on Shenandoah Avenue NW.
 Go .2 miles. DMVCC will be on your left side.

COMING FROM I-81 SOUTH

- I. Take exit 137 for VA-11. Go .3 miles
- 2. Turn right at VA-112 South. Go .4 miles
- 3. Turn left at US-11/US-460. Go 1.3 miles
- 4. Turn right at US-11-ALT/US-460-ALT. Go 1.6 miles
- 5. Turn right at Boulevard Roanoke. Go 2 miles
- Continue on Shenandoah Avenue NW. DMVCC will be on your right side.




STAFFING

ADMISSIONS AND FINANCE


Eligibility requirements for admission include an honorable discharge from the U.S. Armed Forces and Virginia residency, either at the time of admission, or entry into the Armed Forces.

Did you know that DMVCC is anywhere from 40-60% less expensive than nursing facilities that are non-veteran centered?

DMVCC accepts payment from private insurers, Medicare and Medicaid.

Most veterans also qualify for the VA per diem facility credit.
